The Committee values public comments and wishes to convey that although Committee members cannot discuss items that are not on the agenda, they listen carefully and appreciate and value input from the public.

There are two opportunities to address the Committee during the Committee meeting. The first opportunity is during **Public Comments** where the public is invited to make comments on items that are not listed on the current agenda. Public comments are limited to 3 minutes per person. The Committee is scheduled to receive no more than 15 minutes of public comments in total unless the Committee approves a longer period. If more than three persons wish to address the Committee on the same topic, they are encouraged to select a spokesperson. The Committee does not take action or discuss items not appearing on the agenda.

The second opportunity for public input is before the Committee discusses and takes action on a specific Agenda item. The Petaluma Health Care District is governed by a publicly elected five-member Board of Directors to serve Southern Sonoma County, which appoints members of the Finance and Business Development Committee. Finance and Business Development Committee meetings are held the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 4:00 PM unless otherwise noticed.
